

6th International Kiwifruit Symposium

INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS

A formatted template is available for downloading on the Symposium website. Abstracts and the resultant presentation must be in English. The abstract must be prepared using Microsoft Word. In brief:

1. Abstracts are required for all presentations.
2. The title should be brief and explicit.
3. The body of the abstract will be no more than 300 words in length and will be divided into:
 - * Purpose of study
 - * Methods
 - * Results
 - * Conclusions
4. The abstract must contain some results. It is not acceptable to state that the results will be presented at the Symposium.
5. A maximum of two references and one figure (either a simple graph or a table) may be included.
6. The abstract should be typed in 12 point Times Roman font and be left justified. The page margins should be at least 2 cm on all sides.
7. All abbreviations should be defined after the first use of the word. Avoid creating new abbreviations.
8. A statement that institutional ethics committee approval has been obtained must be included if the work involves human or animal subjects.
9. A set of instructions to presenters will be forwarded upon acceptance of the abstract.
